### WEEK ONE

#### Sunday:

*I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever. One generation commends Your works to another; they tell of Your mighty acts. Psalm 145:1,4 NIV*

We praise you, God, our creator, and sustainer of all that is and is to come.

Thank you for the gift of life and for your son, Jesus, who makes eternal life with you possible.

#### Monday:

*If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9 NIV*

Lord, you are the Spirit of Truth. Forgive us for embracing the lies of our culture.

Through your Holy Spirit, may we recognize these lies, value life, and walk in the Truth that will set us free.

#### Tuesday:

*Defend the weak and the fatherless; uphold the cause of the poor and the oppressed. Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked. Psalm 82:3-4 NIV*

Father, you are the author of life. Every human being is created in your very image and likeness.

Please give the church courage and confidence to embrace and show the world the value of each human life.

#### Wednesday: **P**roactive Education Services

*Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men will stumble and fall: but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:30-31 NIV*

We pray for W2W Healthy You™ instructors teaching in over 80 schools and organizations. Give them boldness to proclaim truth and equip students to value themselves, build healthy relationships, and seek your wisdom. May they treasure your word, pursue understanding, and find faith in your son Jesus.

## Today's Challenge:

Think of one or two young people in your life that you can spend some time praying over. Pray for their salvation in Jesus, for their current and future relationships, and for the stamina to continue to walk in Biblical sexuality.

## Thursday: Responsive Medical Services

*Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. John 8:32 NIV*

Lord, we lift up PRC's Medical Services staff, asking for your grace as they equip women with the information needed to choose life. Lord, uphold PRC staff with strength, encouragement, and protection as they minister to those facing unplanned pregnancies. May abortion-minded women feel supported and loved. Give them courage to continue their pregnancies.

Father, grant PRC schedulers insight and discernment as they answer calls and respond to texts. Lord, fill them with wisdom in every conversation and help them recall and apply all they have learned in their training. (Proverbs 31:26)

## Friday: Compassionate Support Services

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-23, 25 NIV*

We pray for wisdom for our advocates who walk alongside our First Steps clients during their pregnancies when they are still vulnerable to making an abortion decision.

God, lead our moms and dads who are parenting babies and toddlers. May our Christ-centered classes, mentoring, community referrals, and gifts of supplies such as diapers, formula, clothes, and pack-n' plays help moms and dads know they are not alone.

Lord, we pray for moms in our Cradles of Grace program who want to go deeper with weekly Bible study and connection to a local church. We pray they may increase in their faith and love for you. Give them the courage to seek out and attend a church service.

## Saturday:

*This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that He hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of Him. 1 John 5:14-15 NIV*

Jesus, we lift up PRC and other life-affirming ministries in the Greater Grand Rapids community as they stand in the gap for those who have no voice and those who feel alone.

Lord, as we unite with fellow believers and pray for life, give us love, boldness, and courage to stand up for each human life.

## WEEK TWO

### Sunday:

*If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14 NIV*

Father, we come before you in stillness, asking you to search our hearts and reveal anything within us that needs to be confessed. We repent of any pride, rebellion, apathy, or judgment that has caused us to stray from your will. Cleanse us and make us new, that we may walk humbly in your presence.

Thank You, Lord, for freely forgiving us of our sins and cleansing us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

### Today's Challenge:

Spend time thinking about your week, noting any moments you fell into sin or gave in to temptation. Pray over these areas, repenting and asking God to forgive you and release you from anything that binds you. (1 Corinthians 10:13)

### Monday:

*Now choose life, so that you and your children may live and that you may love the Lord your God, listen to His voice, and hold fast to Him. Deuteronomy 30:19-20 NIV*

Heavenly Father, thank you that in your grace, you offer the free blessing of salvation to all who will trust in Christ as Savior. Thank you that you loved me so much that you sent Jesus to die in my place so I might be born again and receive the many unconditional blessings of His resurrected life.

Lord, help us to point others to the source of all life! You are the way, the truth, and the life. (1 John 14:6)

### Tuesday:

*It is written, "He said to them, 'My house will be called a house of prayer.'" Matthew 21:13a NIV*

Father, we exalt your name. Restore your kingdom in your church. We repent that we have not been the house of prayer that you have called us to be. Forgive us for our lack of faithful prayer.

### Wednesday:
